Award Details:

Scholarships awarded will be determined by the quantity of eligible submissions received not to exceed \$1,500. Eligible LHS Seniors who plan to continue their education at institutions of higher learning, i.e., universities, colleges, trade, and vocational schools, are encouraged to apply. All Scholarship checks are non-transferrable and are made payable to the winning recipient and their choice of accredited post high school institution (i.e., college, university, vocational school) that they will be attending in the following Fall.

Award Eligibility:

- *Must have a PTSO student or family membership.
- *Must submit a completed essay.
- *Must submit either a School Activities, Community Involvement Sheet, or two Letters of Recommendation.
- *All information in the application is accurate, and the essay included is the applicant's own work.

Application Requirements:

- *Please include a cover sheet.
- *Completed forms should be submitted to LRHSscholarship@gmail.com, **no later than 11:59 PM on February 20, 2023.**
- *All areas on the application form must be completed.
- *Application must be typed. No handwritten applications will be accepted.

Judging Criteria:

Neatness and following directions will be taken into consideration in all scoring. Incomplete applications will not be considered. All applicants will be reviewed in a blind process, with any names/identifying information removed from the application pages. The Scholarship Committee will independently review each application using the following:

- Essay
- School Activities Participation and Awards sheet
- Community/Volunteerism/Other Activities and Awards sheet, **or**
- Essay and Two Letters of Recommendation.

Award recipients will be announced at the Senior Awards Night in May.
